Childhood Cancer STAR Act Passes the Senate



Exciting news! The STAR Act, the most comprehensive childhood cancer bill ever introduced, has passed the Senate. The STAR Act would expand opportunities for childhood cancer research, improve efforts to identify and track childhood cancer incidences, enhance the quality of life for childhood cancer survivors, and ensure publicly accessible expanded access policies that provide hope for patients who have run out of options. 
The Race to Cure Sarcoma™ Kicks off in April
