



2017 Race to Cure Sarcoma™ Season Comes to a Close

The 2017 Race to Cure Sarcoma[™] season has come to an end. The race year finished on high note with a phenomenal slate of events in Richmond, Chicago, Nashville and New Jersey.



Richmond was one of four new races in 2017. More than 200 people attended the race and helped to raise nearly \$18,000 towards sarcoma research. Prior to the race kick-off, participants were inspired by talks from local sarcoma survivors as well as Dr. Sosipatros Boikos, head of the VCU Massey Cancer Center's Sarcoma Program.



<u>Chicago</u> had an impressive turnout in its return as a part of the Race to Cure Sarcoma[™] series. Despite the cold and wet weather, more than 400 participants raised over \$85,000 for the second year in a row.




<u>Nashville</u> came in strong for a first year race, surpassing \$50,000 raised for sarcoma research nationally and locally through the Vanderbilt-Ingram Cancer Center. Participants and supporters enjoyed local foods, live music from native Nashville musicians, and heartfelt stories from survivors, patients and caregivers.



New Jersey wrapped up the 2017 race season as our final first-year race. Just under 200 participants raised more than \$42,000! Family and friends heard from local sarcoma survivors and caregivers who bravely shared their stories. The morning wrapped up with prizes for the top individual fundraiser, top team fundraiser and the largest team.

Sarcoma Foundation of America Sarcoma Research Grant Program

The Sarcoma Foundation of America (SFA) is now accepting research grant proposals. Grants of \$50,000, allowing up to 10 percent indirect costs, are available to cover equipment and supplies in support of research on the etiology, molecular biology, pathogenesis, diagnosis, and treatment of human sarcomas.

The SFA will only accept applications that focus on the following areas of research:

- * Omic characterization of sarcomas and definition of novel targets
- * Omic patterns of sensitivity and resistance to existing agents
- * Systemic therapy combinations
- * Immunotherapy

The SFA raises funds to support basic research focused on discovering and developing new and effective therapies to treat and eradicate sarcoma.



Application deadline is January 31, 2018.
