### When is the race to cure sarcoma Denver?

The Race to Cure Sarcoma Denver will be held on Saturday, September 17, 2016. Registration and packet pick up opens at 8:00 a.m. The race starts at 9:00 a.m.

### Where is it being held?

### What about parking?

### What happens if it rains?

Yes—the course will be a down and back on the Dam Road. Anyone who does not wish to complete the full 5K is welcome to turn around at any point.

### Can I bring a stroller?

This race is for the WHOLE family! Please be respectful to runners and walkers who are trying to pass on the course.

**Are dogs welcome?**

Dogs must also be on a leash.

**What happens after we finish the 5K run/walk?**

Good question! There will be a post-race celebration featuring music, food, and awards along with some words from Dr. Villalobos.
