SFA Attends ASCO Annual Meeting Recpient of SFA/Conquer Cancer Research Grant Announced

Representing sarcoma patients and their families, the Sarcoma Foundation of America (SFA) attended the 2018 American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Annual Meeting. This gathering brings together the leading oncology professionals, researchers, and patient advocates for discussions of the latest in research, treatment advancements, and updates in new therapy development.

SFA has partnered with the Conquer Cancer Foundation, the charitable arm of ASCO, to fund a 2018 research grant. During the annual meeting it was

announced that David S. Shulman, MD, of the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute is the recipient of the Conquer Cancer Foundation of ASCO/Sarcoma Foundation of America Young Investigator Award for his project, "Evaluation of ctDNA as a prognostic biomarker in patients with localized Ewing sarcoma." SFA's CEO, Rich Rumsey, and Senior Manager of Public Policy & External Affairs, Lori Hoffman, had the opportunity to meet with Dr. Shulman to learn more about his work and his efforts in Ewing sarcoma.
